
UNDER PRESSURE

June 2023








Since March 2022, the number of UK adults who are behind on one or more household bill has risen to 1 in 5 from an estimated 7.9 to 11.6 million people.








An estimated 5.5 million people (1 in 10 UK adults) were behind on their energy bills in April – an increase of 2.1 million compared to March 2022.






Another Year of Growth & Change

Another Year of Growth & Change



2022/23 Data

(compared to 2021/22)



- 2607 individuals approached (1043)
- **2955** issues supported with (1217)
- 13 % (330) were under 25 years old (13% 136 people)
- 11% from Black and ethnic (BAME) Communities
- 85% had a disability or long-term illness (81%)
- 56% (1468) were experiencing mental health difficulties (51% -539 people)
- £1,093,702 achieved in Financial Gains (£626,687 previous year)



2023 / 24 Data

Current Position (5 months: 01/04/23 – 31/08/23)

- **1428** individuals approached us (2607 in 22/23)
- **1675** issues supported with (2955 in 22/23)

- £787,383 achieved in Financial Gains (£1,093,702 in 22/23)
- 28% of cases are food parcels & HSF vouchers






Current Position (since April 23)

- Advice Team grown from 7 to 10 Advisers
- No of cases opened
 - Was 192 per month (175 clients)
 - Now 335 per month (286 clients)

Advice Clients story's

Every week a volunteer calls clients whose cases have closed for feedback

Our Residents' Achievements...

- 30 Supported Accommodation Clients moved into their own properties
- Currently 38 people are in accommodation supported by us
- 24 Residents have completed AQA Units between April 2022 and April 2023
- 38 individual units have been completed by our Residents
